**PREREQUISITES:**

Successful completion of the Structural Collapse Technician Course (**A copy of the your Structural Collapse Technician certification must be included with the submission of this application**)

**MINIMUM PERSONNEL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:**

Steel toe/shank boots, low profile helmet, gloves, nomex hood, ANSI Z-87-1 clear lens eye protection, hydrating device (camelback, canteen, old Gatorade bottle) knee pads, elbow pads, an air purification respirator, ear pro, long pants (BDUs, blue or black fire service pants, or coveralls are acceptable), and long sleeve shirts. Extra clothing, to include gloves, raingear (no yellow raingear) and protective footwear is recommended.

**MEAL ARRANGEMENTS:**

Lunch will be provided on each day of instruction – Lunch typically will consist of a hot meal with drinks (soda, water). Limited snacks are provided each day – fruit, candy and snack cakes. Breakfast and Dinner are not included.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

It is the student's responsibility to secure lodging. There are many hotels/motels along the Virginia Beach oceanfront that are available.

We have secured a number of rooms at the **Country Inn & Suites** at a reduced rate - \$50.00 per night plus tax \$7.25 total \$57.25.
