## <u>Personal Protective Equipment</u> <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u>

The following uniform and equipment (known as the equipment) has been issued to you and is the property of The Federal Emergency Management Agency and The City of Virginia Beach. It is your responsibility to maintain this equipment in good condition. You shall notify the Program Manager or Task Force Leader if you damage your equipment in training or during a deployment so repair or replacement can be provided.

Upon completion of service whether by resignation or removal from the Task Force, all equipment shall be returned in its entirety. The list of returned equipment will be compared with the list of issued equipment the Task Force has on file. The cost of the replacement of any missing equipment will be borne by you the member at the current replacement cost. Failure to return all equipment or provide finical restitution to the Task Force for missing equipment within 30 days of separation will constitute legal action against the member including but not limited to obtaining a bench warrant or wage garnishment.
